² Six credits must be in survey courses.

³ English 490 (Senior Research and Writing) is required. Students who demonstrate exceptional ability in writing may satisfy the requirement in advanced writing with English 490 alone, using the other three credits for additional electives in English.

OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS:

In addition to the major requirements, the student should present twelve credits in English and American historical and cultural backgrounds. A third language and other studies in the humanities and social sciences are also recommended as supporting fields for the degree in English.
