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SUBAWARD AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF PUERTO RICO SEA GRANT COLLEGE PROGRAM AND THE UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE

Period Performance

From the date of signature of this agreement by all parties through February 28, 2005. The period of performance can only be extended by modification of this agreement in writing by the University and the Subcontractor.

Project Director

The research program of the Subcontractor will be under the direction of Dr. Havidán Rodríguez, Director of the Disaster Research Center at the University of Delaware.

Allowable Cost and Payment

- a) The estimated cost of performance of this agreement \$34,085, which may not be exceeded. Funds will be made available from the University's account number 535485.
- b) A budget, which is agreed to by the parties to the agreement, is attached and is hereby made a part of the subcontract.
- c) Actual payments will be made within the total so authorized upon receipt of invoices, with a cost breakdown showing expenditure of funds. Invoices should be submitted to
