

AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE
UNIVERSITY OF PUERTO RICO
AND THE
UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA

WHEREAS, the University of Georgia and the University of Puerto Rico, Mayaguez Campus are mutually interested in collaboration in instruction, research, and related activities, and

WHEREAS, the two institutions have cooperated on an informal basis to further these interests and now desire to record here mutual agreement in this regard;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto do hereby record their agreement as follows:



ARTICLE I

This agreement is oriented towards the development of marine sciences by means of mutual cooperation between the University of Georgia and the University of Puerto Rico.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of this Agreement is to further the following objectives:


1. To develop cooperative and collaborative activities in furtherance of the common interest of the two institutions;
2. To develop research and research related activities as may be of mutual interest to both institutions;
3. To participate in cooperative research and educational endeavors to meet human needs;
4. To enlarge and strengthen the capacities and capabilities of each institution through the cooperative use of materials and facilities which are supportive of mutually agreed programs.
5. To promote the exchange of students and faculty between the two institutions for research, education, and training.
6. To facilitate the exchange of scholarly information and materials between the two institutions.



ARTICLE III

To implement the aims and purposes expressed in Articles I and II,
it is mutually understood and agreed:

1. Individual programs of work under this agreement will be jointly planned and conducted and research results and other benefits will be shared and mutually interchanged by the two institutions. Program of work will be reviewed and approved annually by designated representatives of the institutions.
2. In recognition of the mutual interest and benefits to be gained by the University of Georgia and the University of Puerto Rico, Mayaguez Campus, each institution will bear the direct costs associated with its participation in research projects under this agreement. Any commitment of funds will be based on prior review and approval, through normal mechanisms of the institution involved, of the project being proposed and the funding required.



ARTICLE IV

1. In view of the informal cooperative work in progress, this agreement is effective upon its execution by the appropriate officer of each of the signatory institutions.

2. This Agreement may be amended at any time by mutual consent and shall continue in force and affect indefinitely unless terminated by either party by giving written notice of intent to terminate. Insofar as possible such notice will be given one year in advance of the termination date.
