





MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
for
STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The purpose of this memorandum of agreement among the graduate schools of North Carolina A&T State University, University of Puerto Rico-Mayaguez, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, University of Wisconsin-Madison, and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, is to state the terms and conditions under which the graduate student exchange program will be implemented in the proposed National Science Foundation (NSF) Engineering Research Center (ERC) on Power Electronics Systems.

- Exchange students who take courses offered as part of the ERC curriculum, or do ERC-related research at host institutions will pay the appropriate in-state or special tuition and fees of the host institution.
- "Advisor approved" course credits taken by the exchange students will be accepted in the home institutions.
- This agreement will be in force for the lifespan of the ERC.
