and

the Secretary of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, (hereinafter referred to as the DTPW), **Honorable Fernando E. Fagundo Fagundo**,

acting under the Public Law Number 74

of June 23, 1965, as amended [9 LPRA 2004(h)], particularly by Law Number 1 of March 6, 1991, and the Reorganization Plan Number 6 of 1971 (3 LPRA, App. III, Article VI);

As the Second Part: The Mayagüez Campus of the University of Puerto Rico, (hereinafter referred to as the RUM), represented by its Chancellor, **Dr. Jorge Iván** Vélez Arocho,

SET FORTH

WHEREAS, on the 1st of April of 1986, both parties signed a Cooperative Agreement, with the intention of establishing a reciprocal collaboration framework in which the PRHTA would provide financial assistance to the RUM, in order to provide profesional and technical services for research, development, training and other tasks necessary for the development of new technologies and/or improve existing ones.

WHEREAS, the RUM, through its Transportation Technology Transfer Center, within the scope and spirit of this Agreement, has requested, and the PRHTA has approved funds, to finance the development of five (5) seminars, under Special Projects, to be carryout during FY 2004.

WHEREAS, the cost of this project may be charged to PRHTA, under **Project**PR-18-X011 from the Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) of the Federal

Transit Administration (FTA).

WHEREAS, the RUM will cause work on the seminars to be commenced within a reasonable time after execution of this AGREEMENT and that it shall use its best efforts to complete the work in twenty-four (24) months from the effective date of this AGREEMENT or until the funds are released by the Federal Agency, whichever comens first.
